

China: Danish companies sign strategic Memorandum of Understanding with Nanjing High Tech Zone

During Martin Lidegaard's two-day visit to China, seven Danish companies signed a strategic partnership agreement with Nanjing High Tech Zone. Nanjing is currently building a sustainable industrial park for biopharmaceutical companies.

Cowi will be main advisor for the planning among others including the planning and establishment of district heating and water supply. The Eco park project will upgrade an existing industrial and service area of 19.2 square metres. Cowi and Archiland International have previously signed an agreement to build a Nanjing "green lighthouse", an exhibition centre for urban planning.
