Policy & Action Matrix for AWPGE

- **A blueprint** for matching the new policy guidelines for PPPs in the energy sector with best international practices
- Identify initial and high prioritized initiatives vs. longterm sustainable procedures
- Appoint the different themes and sectorial focuses to the relevant implementing authorities and responsible units in Ethiopia
- A solid reference to ensure an effective cross-functional workflow among the different government organizations of the country

Wind Project Development Process

- Focus on optimal distribution of public and private tasks and responsibilities
- How to enable solid legal and regulatory frameworks



Public De-risking of Wind Projects

- Clear and Reliable National Energy Action Plans
- Suitable legal and regulatory frameworks
- Long-term visibility of **projects pipeline**
- Appropriate organizational anchoring and staffing of a dedicated government agency for IPP transactions
- Transparent and coordinated approval systems
 Nodal Gov. Agency (i.e. one-stop-shop) to reduce risks for developers/investors in all project steps

Public De-risking of Wind Projects

- **Coordination:** ensure a high involvement and coordination with the TSO for the determination of auction sizes, site selection and timing of projects
- Efficiency and certainty in tender process: adequate prequalification criteria, evaluation mechanism, timeline, deadlines, penalties
- **Consultation** with industry and **dialogue** with current and potential bidders
- Tender Doc. Package: simple, clear and bankable

Public De-risking of Wind Projects

- **Project Bankability**: sound financial package (PPA, etc.) & credit enhancement instruments
- Bid evaluation: ensure that the weighting system for price and non-price components in the evaluation of the bids reflect the Gov. 's priorities
- LCRs: phase-in LCRs according to a realistic state-of-art of the Ethiopian manufacturing industry across the wind value chain (high quality standards in WTG's)
