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Executive Order no. 1165 of 11/08/2022 (Applicable)

Executive Order on certain areas in Denmark that are open for the successive awarding of licenses for the investigation and storage of carbon dioxide

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Pursuant to Section 23b(1)(2) of the Act on the Use of Denmark's Subsoil; cf. Executive Order no. 1533 of 16 December 2019, which has determined by authority pursuant to Section 3(1)(1) and Section 4(1) of Executive Order no. 2573 of 22 December 2021 on the Tasks and Powers of the Danish Energy Agency:

§ 1. The area on the Danish continental shelf west of 6° 15' E and north of 56° 00' N, is open for applications for licenses to investigate and store carbon dioxide from 15 August 2022 to 1 October 2022.

Subsection 2. Applications can then be submitted to the Danish Energy Agency every year in the period 15 August to 1 October of the same year.

§ 2. A decision on the awarding of licenses shall be taken at the end of each application period; cf. § 1(1) and (2). Licenses are awarded after submission to a committee appointed by the Danish Parliament in accordance with Section 23(8) of the Danish Subsoil Act.

§ 3. The Executive Order will enter into force on 15 August 2022.
