Agreement between The Danish Energy Technology Development and Demonstration programme (EUDP) and The Department of International Cooperation of the Chinese Ministry of Science and Technology (hereafter referred to as the Parties), concerning Joint Call for Proposals in 2013.

The Parties, represented by,

Mr Thomas Egebo, Permanent Secretary of State, Ministry of Climate Energy and Buildings, representing the Danish Government on behalf of the The Danish Energy Technology Development and Demonstration programme (EUDP),

and

Mr Chen Linhao, Deputy Director-General, representing the Department of International Cooperation of the Chinese Ministry of Science and Technology

respectively, acknowledging the Memorandum of Understanding signed 16th June 2012 in Copenhagen, <u>have agreed</u>:

- 1. Without prejudice to national legislation to implement a joint call for proposals for energy technology development and demonstration projects.
- 2. The purpose of the call for proposals shall be to promote the use of renewable energy sources, technology development, and a mutually beneficial cooperation between Sino-Danish organizations, with a focus on public-private partnerships.
- 3. The call for proposals shall be limited to include projects within the priority technology areas of smart grids and wind energy, which could be further extended in the future cooperation.
- 4. The call for proposals shall be implemented in 2013, with a possibility for repetition.
- 5. The Parties shall, following their respective approval processes, jointly agree on which projects to fund.

- 6. Management of the call is jointly carried out by the Parties, or by duly authorized representative.
- 7. The joint call shall be evaluated jointly after its completion, in the end of 2013, with a view to decide on a continuation.
- 8. The Parties endeavor to further investigate opportunities for the establishment of a Sino-Danish innovation center in the field of smart grids, renewable energy sources, and energy efficiency, which will serve as a platform for scientific and technological cooperation for the participating parties.
- 9. Any disputes shall be solved amicably in a friendly manner through consultations.
