

DONG excercised the state participation in all licenses for oil and gas exploration and production awarded in the period of 1984-2004.

The Danish North Sea Fund have taken over DONG's role from 2004 and from 2005 thus functions as state participant with 20 % in all new exploration licenses (at present 19 licenses).
