The Executive Order regarding certain onshore areas in Denmark that are open for awarding of licenses for the exploration and storage of carbon dioxide

The following shall be laid down pursuant to sections 23b(1), no. 2, of the Act on the Use of the Danish Subsoil, cf. Consolidated Act no. 1461 of 29 November 2023, and with authorisation pursuant to section 4(1) and 3(1), no. 1, of Executive Order no. 1366 of 28 September 2022 on the Tasks and Powers of the Danish Energy Agency:

- 1.- Areas as defined in Appendices 1 and 2 are open for applications for a license for exploration and use of the subsoil for geological carbon dioxide storage from 13 December 2023 to 24 January 2024.
- **2.-** Licenses will be granted upon submission to a committee set up by the Danish Parliament (Folketing) in accordance with section 23(8) of the Danish Subsoil Act.
- 3.- This Executive Order shall enter into force on 13 December 2023.
